WHEN: Homework will be set each Monday and will be due for completion on the following Friday, allowing 4 school evenings for completion.

TIME: Maximum of 25 minutes of homework per day. Homework tasks will not be assigned over the weekends or during the holidays.

FOCUS:

- Practise and consolidate the concepts that have been introduced during class time.
- Introduce self-discipline and responsibility.
- **Reading - Develop consistency through daily reading to, with, or by parents/carers.**
- **Mathematics - Practise of mathematics skills**
- **Word study, including spelling, phonics as well as handwriting – Will be introduced as required.**
