Parents are encouraged to read the Highvale Primary School Homework Policy located under policies on our school website https://highvaleps.vic.edu.au/parent-information/.

WHEN: Homework will be set each Monday fortnight and will be due for completion on the second following Friday, allowing 9 school evenings for completion.

TIME: **Maximum** of 30 minutes of homework per day. Homework tasks will not be assigned over the weekends or during the holidays.

FOCUS:

- Practise and consolidate the concepts that have been introduced during class time.
- Embed self-discipline and responsibility.
- Reading Develop consistency through daily reading to, with, or by parents/carers.
- Mathematics Practise of mathematics skills
- Word study, including spelling and phonics will be introduced as required.
- Where appropriate, students may be introduced to tasks which require them to gather information or materials to support a class inquiry concept.
- Where required, homework may include the completion of unfinished class work.

 Weekly Reading of 20 minutes a day, four times a week totalling 80 minutes a week. Record each reading session in your student diary and have it signed by an adult. Teachers will check entries each Friday. Complete assigned Reading Eggs tasks. Our focus over the coming weeks will be persuasive texts. 	 Practise your individual words which are written in your Student Diary. Words will be part of our specific Letters and Sounds learning for the week. Spelling words will be tested each week. Record the strategy you used to practise your words. For example Look, Say, Cover, Write and Check. 	Topic Addition and Subtraction Activities Parents are able to view the required tasks in Mathletics. The list for completion will appear as soon as your child logs into their Mathletics account. Choice Once assigned Mathletics activities are complete, students may work on Multiverse or choice tasks. Students can also access Essential Assessment Sunset Maths to practise their fluency (example – number facts) skills.
