
Capture the Island Area Challenge

You will need:

Capture the Island game board, two coloured crayons, coordinate cards.

Instructions:

- 1. Each player chooses a coloured crayon and writes their name at the top of the board. Cut out the coordinate cards and place them face down in a pile.
- 2. Player one takes a card from the top of the pile and plots the four points. Player 1 then uses their crayon to join the points and form a rectangle. Player one calculates the area of the shape, writes the number inside, and colours the island to capture it.
- 3. Player 2 takes a card from the pile and repeats step 2 using their crayon to plot and capture an island.
- 4. Players take it in turns until there are no cards left.
- 5. At the end of the game, players add up their points. The player with the largest total area of captured islands is the winner!
