Optional Education Items

Excursions and Incursions that broaden the learning experience of students will be charged individually throughout the year. **The total cost of excursions and incursions will be between \$90 and \$100 per year.**

Costs will cover attendance at ALL class incursions held at the school and ALL class excursions in 2021 that support the educational program expected at Highvale. Where buses are required for transport, only seat belted buses are booked. This payment also covers the optional Languages and Performing Arts incursions and excursions. Parents will receive a notice prior to each activity outlining all relevant information and any student requirements.

Please note, however that, camps, Year 6 Graduation, swimming, Family Life, fundraising activities and other special events or additional opportunities which may arise throughout the school year are not covered in the excursion payment. This includes occasions where students are selected for a particular program or event, for example, District Chess. Where this occurs, parents and carers will be invoiced separately if required. Please note that parents and carers are required to provide supervision for their own child and transport to and from these events.

Year 6 Interschool Sports Pre payment

Planning for participation in this program depends upon the timely commitment of other schools, transport and entrance costs. This can fluctuate from term to term. Therefore in 2021, the Interschool Sports Payment will be billed quarterly. This termly payment applies to all Year 6 students. Prior to the commencement of each term, all students in Year 6 will be invoiced to cover the cost of transport to and from events as well as entrance and hire of facility and equipment charges. Last year's Term 1 payment was \$12.00. We expect the payment for Term 1, 2021 to be similar. This will be invoiced at the start of term next year when we are confident that interschool will be going ahead.

Where the number of Year 6 students does not meet the quota for a particular event, Year 5 students will be provided with the opportunity to participate in Interschool sport. In 2020, selected Year 5 students will be invoiced as per event.

Please note, the Interschool Sports Payment does not include other additional opportunities where competitors are individually selected or qualified from preliminary events or trials including: Swimming programs, District Cross Country, District Athletics, District Basketball, District Soccer or any other selected sports team. Competitors for these individual or team events will be invoiced separately for each event if required. Please note that parents and carers are required to provide supervision for their own child and transport to and from these events.
