Instruments

Normally students are only able to hire instruments for their first year of learning, but in some cases, particularly for more expensive instruments, students can continue hiring after their first year.

- All instruments require accessories including music books and music stands, plus instrument-specific items such as reeds, neck straps, cleaning cloths, and valve oil. These will be communicated to you by your child's instrumental music teacher, and these items can be purchased through a music store, or sometimes through the school.

I understand that additional books and accessories may be required for music lessons and agree to provide these in consultation with my child's music teacher.

- At Highvale Primary School, band is a compulsory part of the Instrumental Music Program, which gives students opportunities to perform and to develop their team skills in music. Students enrolled in lessons commit both to their weekly lessons during school hours and a weekly band rehearsal before school.

- By submitting this form, you are enrolling your child in instrumental music lessons for 2024 and making a financial commitment. Students will automatically continue each term unless their Instrumental Music teacher receives written/emailed notice by Monday of the final week of the previous term.
