  items such as reeds, neck straps, cleaning cloths, and valve oil. These will be communicated to you by
  your child's instrumental music teacher, and these items can be purchased through a music store, or
  sometimes through the school.

- At Highvale Primary School, band is a compulsory part of the Instrumental Music Program, which gives students opportunities to perform and to develop their team skills in music. Students enrolled in lessons commit both to their weekly lessons during school hours and a weekly band rehearsal before school.
